Over the course of his military career, he served as a cryptologic linguist at overseas and stateside locations; an Air Training Command master instructor, language course developer and education evaluator; a national counter-narcotics training course manager. He served as the creator and director of Senior Executive Service leadership development courses for the National Security Agency (NSA) and CIA.

Mr. Ferrer has been *in the fight* to defend our nation and way of life for over three decades. He has personally worked against groups such as: Socialist nation-states; Communist terror and guerilla groups; illicit narcotics traffickers; cyber criminals; and (currently) extremist terrorist organizations.
