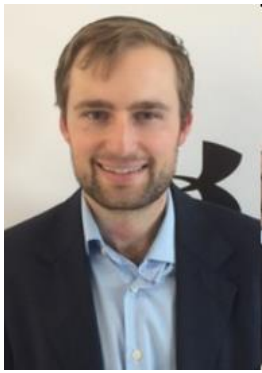


How does Commitment Change Us?
