Brian Kelly

Head Men's Lacrosse Coach Goucher College



Brian is the Head Men's Lacrosse Coach at Goucher College. A Baltimore native, Kelly played high school lacrosse at Towson High School before playing collegiately at CCBC Essex and then at perennial national powerhouse Johns Hopkins. A midfielder, Kelly was a second-team NJCAA All-American with the Knights in 1991, helping lead CCBC Essex to a NJCAA national championship that year. At Johns Hopkins, the Blue Jays reached the NCAA semifinals in each of his final two seasons at the school (1992 and 1993). Kelly was named an honorable mention All-American midfielder by the USILA in 1993, and he was also the recipient of the Turnbull-Reynolds Award which is given to a player who displays outstanding character and leadership. Brian was recently inducted into the NJCAA Lacrosse Hall of Fame in 2015. He previously served as the top offensive assistant coach of the Goucher men's lacrosse program. He is only the fourth head coach in the 22-year history of the program.

Kelly led the Gophers to an 8-8 record in his debut season in 2013, with a perfect 6-0 mark in the Landmark Conference regular season. The Gophers reached the Landmark Conference playoffs in his first two seasons at the helm, including a championship appearance in 2014. Under his leadership, Goucher has a record of 31-29 and his players have received 17 all-conference selections, including eight who garnered first-team accolades. While being at the helm of the Gopher program Kelly has coached two players who have been recognized as honorable mention All-America.

Brian graduated from Johns Hopkins in 2003 with a degree in social and behavioral sciences. Kelly's business career was in commercial real estate, serving as Vice President of Asset Management for Deutsche Bank RREEF from 2005-2012.

Kelly recently took over as the Director of the FCA Maryland Club Lacrosse Program. This speaks to his consistent connection to the sport since leaving Johns Hopkins. He served as an assistant coach with the MLL's Washington Bayhawks in 2008. He coached in the Baltimore Crabs Club Lacrosse Program for nine years, coaching many current and former Division 1, Division 2 and Division 3 standouts. Brian Kelly has said "having the opportunity to provide youth lacrosse players an environment surrounded by coaches, volunteers, and families who want to develop not only the player but also the heart of a player is an exciting endeavor in my lacrosse career and my personal development as a man of faith."

Kelly resides in Lutherville with his wife, Holly, son, Will, and daughter, Grace. In his spare time, he serves as a Student Ministry Leader at the nearby Church of the Nativity.
